Online FEIF Education Seminar April 2021

"Good and Harmonious Riding"

We are happy to offer an online trainer/instructor seminar in co-operation with Gait Academy, the Norwegian Icelandic Horse Association (NIHF) and FEIF!

As far as FEIF is concerned, this seminar should count for the purpose of continuous professional development for trainers (16 units) which are licenced in their national association - but please check with your national organisation. It will be held in English.

The seminar procedure will allow enough time between the separate sessions that you can watch the material, which will be available in the library, as many times as you like.

Stian Pedersen, who is a Hólar graduate, FEIF level 4 instructor and World Champion, and Bent Rune Skulevold, renown trainer and International FEIF Sport Judge, are the founders of GaitAcademy, being a school of equitation for Riders and Instructors approaching good and harmonious riding.

The seminar has several phases and offers a process to make sure everyone can learn in his or her own tempo. Everything is recorded and shared for a certain period of time. The main focus of the seminar series is on the practical tasks during the weeks and then link theory up to practice and share the experience.

Eligible participants: Trainers/instructors registered on the FEIF matrix list have priority. Interested persons not listed on the FEIF matrix can register for the waiting list and will receive confirmation of a seat by April 6th,2021. Waiting list places will be distributed in the order of registration. (https://www.feif.org/education-dept/trainers/)

Requirements: you need internet and a phone, tablet or computer to follow the seminar. The Zoom app needs to be downloaded installed and you need a functioning audio and video on your device. Gait Academy has their own website for the seminar – learning room, suitable for sharing videos. The learning room are with learning paths, so you can keep track yourself, and the organizers can always see how long each participant has come.

The seminar will use ZOOM as platform. Please make sure that you install and test it before the start of the seminar.

Before the start of the seminar, you will receive a short survey that we ask you to complete. This will help us to better steer the contents of the seminar.

Case studies:

We need 4-6 riders who are willing to participate also practically. Everyone who wants to participate with a horse, must state this in the registration, you will be sent a separate survey where you can write a little more about the horse/yourself// where you are in training / what you need guidance on. The seminar organizers will make a selection based on the results of the digital surveys. The riders selected will get 3 individual live online lessons during the seminar. The recordings will be used as seminar case studies and the 3rd live online lesson will be before or during the Zoom meetings April 21st and 22nd. Used equipment has to follow FEIF rules and regulations.

Requirements to participate in practice:

- Someone needs to film you while being logged in to Zoom.
- Internet access stable upload speed of at least 2GB (preferably more)
- Wireless headset to listen and talk to Gait Academy while riding
- Good light conditions

The instructions will take place digitally and LIVE via zoom.

Riding-dates and times are booked directly with Gait Academy (4 to 6 participants) for the Case Study Riders. If you are selected, you will get separate teaching lessons and you will book your exact time with Gait Academy directly, here are the possible dates:

- 1 electronic equipment check from week 12 and during the Easter days
- 2. First lessons: between April 6-9th.
- 3. Second Lessons between April 12-14th
- 4. Third Lessons: between April 19- 20th
